Summary

Responsibilities

- Provide geological support for the operated developments.

- Develop a thorough geological understanding and description of the various fields and the relevant reservoir properties and characteristics.
- Construct appropriate geological models and play a key role in the development of dynamic reservoir models.
- Provide key input into the field volumetrics and reserve estimates and ensuring these are appropriately maintained.
